- ✓ Updated and improved volunteer training
- ✓ Family lunch before camp to meet the community



Post-camp surveys showed

that of families who responded:

- 100% reported that their camper **bonded with those with similar experiences**
- 88% reported that their camper's **independence** improved
- 88% reported that their camper **made a new friend**
- 75% reported that their camper's **social skills** improved
- 75% reported that their camper's **self-esteem** improved

Looking Forward

Families are telling us they want to come to camp together so we are piloting some new opportunities. We need more volunteers to make this happen so we are focusing on retention and recruitment, as well as growing our funding base to ensure we have the funds necessary to meet the needs of our community.
