



Volunteer Opportunity: Camp Director

About Us

Camp Quality provides free, inclusive-year round programs for children with cancer and blood disorders that support the whole family through fun camp adventures. We facilitate a 1-week overnight camp program, hosted at Variety Camp Brereton in Whiteshell Provincial Park, Manitoba. Camp Quality was brought to Canada in 1988, initiated by a group of dedicated volunteers in Southern Ontario. Our overnight camp programs serve campers between the ages of 7 - 17. We are seeking enthusiastic and motivated volunteers for our summer camp program.

The Role

The Camp Director role is an unpaid volunteer position. This position reports to the Camp Coordinator & Sr. Director, Operations & Strategy.

Role Overview

The Camp Director will support the mission of Camp Quality by ensuring that all programs in their region follow policies and procedures, are financially sound, and ensure programs demonstrate the fundamentals of intentional programming to meet all needs of participants. The Camp Director works to select and manage the Camp Organizing Committee, schedule meetings, hold COC accountable and enforce policies and procedures to ensure the smooth operation of camp programs. They work closely with the Support Centre, in areas of training, program development, camper and volunteer support, and risk management. The Camp Director supervises the administration of the camp budget and authorizes all expenditures.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Manage the year-round Camp Organizing Committee, ensuring all tasks are completed in a timely manner.
- Support volunteer and camper recruitment and screening.
- Support the medical team in preparation for camp and ensuring a safe experience for all participants.
- With support of the Sr. Director of Programs, develop and deliver training for volunteers.
- Support the planning of the camp program schedule and review with the medical team.
- Ensure all risk management policies are adhered to.
- Ensure child protection requirements are met and report and non-compliance.





- Support volunteer appreciation and recognition.
- Provide feedback to volunteers as needed.
- Support with camp behaviour management.
- Oversee emergency procedures and protocols

Preferred Skills, Qualifications and Experience

- Passion for the Camp Quality Mission.
- Previous experience working with children and/or special needs populations in a camp setting.
- Proven experience in facilitating activities.
- Strong Collaboration and team building skills.
- Strong Communication skills, both verbal and written.
- Demonstrate flexibility, creative program-solving and optimism in the face of obstacles.
- Confidence in public speaking and leading large groups.
